What Will You Learn?

ElevateUP offers a Client and Professional Services Certificate through five courses and a final capstone project spanning twelve weeks in a blended format (in-person, online, and/or community-based).

Health, Wellbeing and Life teaches essential life skills, including goal-setting, healthy habits, communication, self-care and conflict resolution.

Working in Finance and Other Professional Environments teaches professionalism, Canadian work etiquette, organization and critical thinking.

Equity, Diversity & Incllusion fosters inclusive mindsets, discussing bias, diversity, and equity to create inclusive workplaces and empower advocacy.

Financial Fundamentals shifts mindsets towards saving, covering personal finance concepts like budgeting, investing, credit, taxes and fraud.

Career Essentials Toolkit hones job application skills, resumes, cover letters, networking, hidden job market and understanding employee rights.

Student-Directed Capstone Project enhances research, innovation, leadership, and presentation skills through a self-directed project.

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
